


**CENTRAL AMERICA: CHART OF NATIONAL POPULATION GROWTH

Population growth rate in Central America & Caribbean; definition: The average annual percent change in the population, resulting from a surplus (or deficit) of births over deaths and the balance of migrants entering and leaving a country. 3. The Average Annual Growth Rate (AAGR) of the Protestant Population in each country of Central America was calculated by the author based on a study of public opinion polls on religious affiliation in each country by reputable companies for the period 1990-2010.
